

SAMPLE QUESTIONS DURING AN INTERVIEW:

Perhaps have someone ask you these questions and role play like a real interview to practice. If you're unprepared for questions like this, it can be awkward, embarrassing, or make you nervous so it helps to think of answers ahead of time!

Please tell me about yourself; describe yourself
Where did you attend school?
Describe your most rewarding high school experience.
What high school subjects did you like best and worst? Why?

Where have you worked before?
Why did you leave your last job (or volunteer position)?
Where was your last job (of where did you volunteer)?
What did you like about it or dislike about it?

What makes you qualified for this job?
Why did you apply for this job?
Why should I hire you?
How can you contribute to our company?

How do you handle stress? Example.
How do you handle difficult situations? Give example.
What makes you lose your temper?

What are your hobbies?
What kind of skills do you have that would help you in this job?
What tasks will you need supervision with or help with?

What are your plans for the future? Career goals?
How long do you expect to work here? (EX: "I see no reason why I'd quit")

What are your strengths? (EX: "I work well with people, work well under pressure, I'm thorough with my assignments, etc.")
What are your weaknesses? ("I'm a perfectionist but it's because I want to do my best")

Do you drive? Do you own your own car?
What hours can you work?
What days can you work?

Do you have any questions about working here?
How do you feel about someone your age being your supervisor? (EX: "Age doesn't matter")
